You can donate any “property or services” that would benefit the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club.

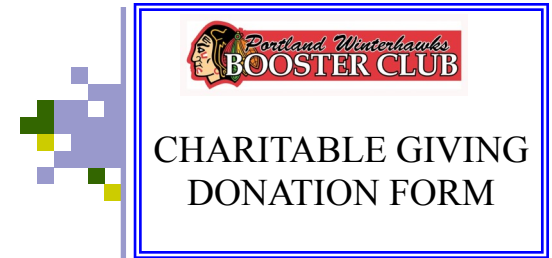

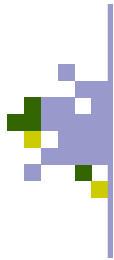

Charitable Bequests: A charitable bequest is simply a distribution from your estate to a charitable organization through your Last Will and Testament. There are different kinds of bequests. For each, you must use very specific language to indicate the precise direction of your estates assets, and to successfully carry out your final wishes. It is very important to discuss your wishes with your legal or financial representatives to properly carry out your bequest. Here is a sampling of "clauses" that would be in a will:

General Bequest: "I give, devise, and bequeath to the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club, Portland, Oregon, the sum of \$_____ (or a description of specific asset, e.g., Hockey Collection), for the benefit of the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club and its general purposes."

Specific Bequest: I give, devise, and bequeath to the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club, Portland, Oregon, the sum of \$_____ (or a description of specific asset, e.g., Hockey Collection), for the benefit of the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club to be used for the following purpose (list purpose(s)). If at any time in the judgment of the trustees of the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club it is impossible or impracticable to carry out exactly the designated purpose, they shall determine an alternative purpose closest to the designated purpose(s)."

Residuary Bequest: "All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, I give to the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club, Portland, Oregon for its general purposes."

Contingency Bequests: "I devise and bequeath the residue of the property, real and personal and wherever situated, owned by me at my death, to (name of beneficiary), if (she/he) survives me. If (name of beneficiary) does not survive me, I devise and bequeath my residuary estate to the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club, Portland, Oregon, for its general purposes."

Again, you must communicate your final wishes to your attorney and/or financial accountants. Last Will and Testaments must conform to specific laws in order to be valid; it is NOT RECOMMENDED that you prepare a "self Will" without having it checked for legal deficiencies. Without doing so your Will can be declared invalid.
